Driver Installation Guide

About the driver software

This software is a special driver for inputting and outputting audio signals from the computer. To use this unit, connect it to a computer on which Windows or Mac OS X is installed and install the driver software on the computer beforehand.

Software end user license agreement

This Software End User License Agreement ("Agreement") is between you (both the individual installing the Program and any single legal entity for which the individual is acting) ("You" or "Your") and PIONEER CORPORATION ("Pioneer").

 - a To install a single copy of the Program in Your computer or mobile device, to use the Program only for Your personal purpose complying with this Agreement and the Documentation ("Authorized Use");

 - c To make one copy of the Program solely for backup purposes, provided that all titles and trademark, copyright and restricted rights notices are reproduced on the copy.

- When using a 64-bit version of Windows, the driver software can only be used for 32-bit applications.
- Turn off this unit's power switch, then disconnect the USB cable connecting this unit and the computer.
- If any other programs are running on the computer, quit them.
- If you connect this unit to your computer without installing the driver software first, an error may occur on your computer depending on the system environment.

Installing the driver software

Obtaining the driver software

1 Launch a web browser on the computer and access the Pioneer DJ support site below. http://pioneerdj.com/support/

2 Click [Software Download] under [XDJ-RX] on the Pioneer DJ support site.

3 Click the icon of the driver software to download the driver software from the download page.

For information on installing the driver software, see the Pioneer DJ support site.

Installation Procedure (Windows)

 To install or uninstall the driver software, you need to be authorized by the administrator of your computer. Log on as the administrator of your computer before proceeding with the installation.

1 Double-click the downloaded driver software (XDJ-RX_#.###.exe).

The driver installation screen appears.

#.### indicates the driver software's version.

2 When the language selection screen appears, select [English] and click [OK].

You can select one from multiple languages depending on the system environment of your computer.

3 Read the [Software end user license agreement] carefully, check the [I agree] box if you consent to provisions of the [Software end user license agreement], and then click [OK].

If you do not consent to the provisions of the [**Software end user** license agreement], click [**Cancel**] and stop installation.

4 Proceed with installation according to the instructions on the screen.

If **[Windows Security**] appears on the screen while the installation is in progress, click **[Install this driver software anyway**] and continue with the installation.

- When the installation program is completed, a completion message appears.
- When the installation of the driver software is completed, you need to reboot your computer.

Installation procedure (Mac OS X)

 To install or uninstall the driver software, you need to be authorized by the administrator of your computer. Have the name and password of the administrator of your computer ready in advance.

1 Double-click the downloaded [XDJ-RX_M_#.#.dmg] file.

The contents of [XDJ-RX_M_#.#.dmg] are displayed. #.### indicates the driver software's version.

2 Double-click [XDJ-RXAudioDriver.pkg].

The driver installation screen appears.

3 Check the details on the screen and click [Continue].

4 Once the License agreement screen is displayed, select [English]. Read the [Software end user license agreement] and click [Continued].

You can select one from multiple languages depending on the system environment of your computer.

5 Click [Agree] box if you consent to provisions of the [Software end user license agreement].

If you do not consent to the provisions of the [Software end user license agreement], click [Disagree] and stop installation.

6 Proceed with installation according to the instructions on the screen.

- Click [Cancel] to cancel installation after it has started.
- When the installation of the driver software is completed, you need to reboot your computer.

Connecting this unit and a computer by USB

1 Connect this unit to your computer via a USB cable.

2 Press the [O] switch.

Turn on the power of this unit.

 When using Windows, a message stating [Installing device driver software] may appear when the unit is first connected to the computer, or when it is connected to a different USB port on the computer. Wait a while until the message [Your devices are ready for use] appears.

Adjusting the buffer size (Windows)

This unit functions as an audio device conforming to the ASIO standards.

 If an application using this unit as the default audio device (DJ software, etc.) is running, quit that application before adjusting the buffer size.

1 Click the Windows [Start] menu>[All

Programs]>[Pioneer]>[XDJ_RX]>[XDJ-RX Setting Utility].
 For Windows 8, click [XDJ-RX Setting Utility] from the [Start] screen.

2 Click the [ASIO] tab.



 If the buffer size is made large, drops in audio data (breaks in the sound) occur less easily, but the time lag due to the delay in the transfer of the audio data (latency) increases.
